

MIGHTY MOMENTS OF 2022





Growing up with HIV, receiving an education & hope for the future.

Manisha Goswami is a 21 year old soon-to-be university graduate who has been a resident of our partner home since she was 12 years old. Born HIV positive, Manisha comes from a village in rural Rajasthan where nutrituous food, life saving medication & quality education were not accessible. Her widowed mother was required to travel 100km every 60 days to receive their ART medication & Manisha was faced with a bleak future without means to progress.



In March 2022 we sat down with Manisha to hear where she's headed and how different her life could have been without the education she's received.



"People believe HIV is a big deal, but it's not.

My life is not affected by HIV because I live a normal life. I am healthy & strong."



"I came to stay at Rays for an education, medication & food.

My father died when I was 5 years old. My life has become so nice at Rays & I'm thankful for this big family that is here"



"All my achievements in life are my education.

I will become a government agent which is a different future I didn't think I would get to receive."



"It feels good to get an education.

I can work towards a career and also have a family of my own one day. That also feels good."



"People are afraid because they don't know.

I've experienced stigma in schools. People should support children like me because we're all the same."

EQUALITY & QUALITY IN EDUCATION ACCESSIBILITY

The primary education issues we addressed this year is the limited accessibility due to the majority of our beneficiaries residing in rural Rajasthani villages.

Secondly, the schools they are able to access are government run which often lack proper infrastructure like class rooms, black boards, drinking water, toilets and sanitary facilities.

The dropout rates for children affected by HIV are significantly higher due to the blatant stigma & discrimination still rampant in rural areas due to lack of information.
